

The Historical Metallurgy Society has just published its research framework for archaeometallurgy in the British Isles. It has three sections that describe the types of evidence that exist, the methods used in researching the history of metallurgy, and the present level of knowledge and understanding of a selection of topics dating from the Bronze Age to the 20th century. The final section sets an agenda for future research. There are 96 pages and 88 figures, most in full colour, a full bibliography and an index.

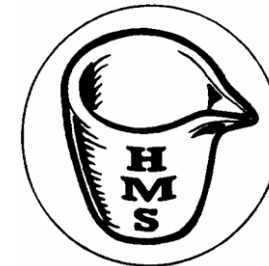
